- The Tobacco Free Cultural Arts Assembly is sponsored and paid for by the Howard County Health Department, with funding from the Cigarette Restitution Fund. It will take place at HES for 3rd, 4th and 5th grades students. "Stay Tobacco Free" is a fast paced, "hip-hop" musical that delivers a powerful message about the dangers of smoking. Through the course of the play, the audience learns that smoking can cause health issues. They also learn about secondhand smoke, how to talk to a smoker about quitting, and the dangers of e-cigarettes.
